



Knebworth School Autism Offer

Mrs Rix, our Assistant Head/Inclusion manager, is the registered Autism Lead for our school. She is your initial point of contact if you need information about services available.

Every child with autism at Knebworth School will be given a Pupil Passport that highlights their strengths, interests and needs. This will be reviewed on a regular basis.

We have many safe places in our school which your child can access in order to have a calm and quiet space free from any distractions.

Our staff have been trained by the Autism Education Trust to ensure that everyone who comes into contact with your child has a greater understanding of their individual needs.

We ensure that there is a positive 'Transition Pathway' that will support transitions within the school and when your child moves on to their next school.

We ensure that we have strong Parental partnerships so that any change in your child's circumstances are quickly responded to and needs are met. This relies on two way open parental communication between home and school.

We endeavour to listen to your child's views, we take in to consideration that children have different ways of communicating and we will need appropriate strategies to support them.
